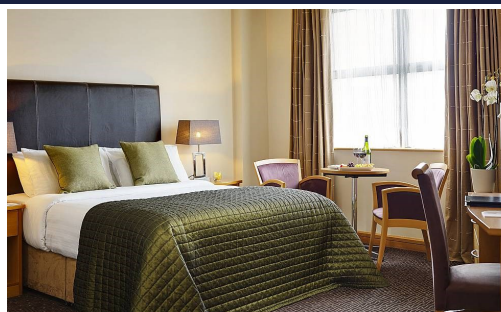
ACCOMMODATION

From Dublin, there are regular bus and train services. Dublin is approximately 2.5 hours from Galway.

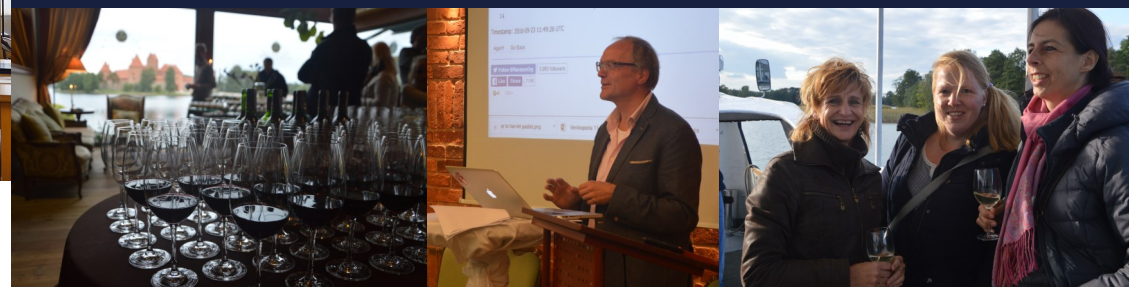
