#### ACCOMODATION and TRAVEL

The Novotel (Katelijnestraat 65b, Bruges) and Ibis (Katelijnestraat 65A, Bruges) hotels are located in center of Bruges, next to each other.

The hotels are just a 15-minute walk from Bruges train station, offering a direct bus and train link from and to Brussels airports.
